We made the <u>decision</u> to move Tim to the other department. The waiter is coming. Quick, make up your mind what you want. Making career choices can be difficult. You made a commitment to volunteer for 3 months? It's easier to make <u>promises</u> than to keep them. What offer did they make us? The hospital has made several <u>purchases</u> for new equipment. We hope to make a <u>deal</u> with them next week. Why can't they make an exception? It's dangerous when you make too many assumptions. They made a <u>prediction</u> that Valladolid would win the League.
